On behalf of the University of Wisconsin - Milwaukee Student Chapter of Engineers Without Borders (EWB@UWM), we would like to thank you for your generous donation to support our cause. Your donation helped EWB@UWM raise \$21,000 that was spent in the construction of a potable water distribution system supplying water to 70 households in the Guatemalan village of La Libertad this past January.

La Libertad has a population of approximately 400 people and 70 families. We designed a system of over 1300 meters of pipeline that chlorinates mountain spring water and distributes up to 80 liters of water per person per day to individual homes. As part of the sustainability of the project, we worked directly with the people of La Libertad to construct the system, as well as a Guatemalan non-profit organization called Agua Para La Salud (APS) whose presence helped with the planning, communication, and construction of the project. This network allows us to work at the highest level of efficiency and trust while in Guatemala. As a result, EWB@UWM has been requested to design and construct another water system in the neighboring villages of Vijolom III and Vitostix in 2011.

EWB@UWM realizes the time and effort you put forth on our behalf helping us raise \$4000 toward our goal of \$21,000. We are very excited and grateful to partner with CannedWater4Kids to help complete upcoming projects bringing clean water to people all over the world.
